Family of Humanity, Inc. a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization is steadily building awareness in the Hollywood community and is becoming noticed by community leaders of all types. FOH has expanded

its programs to serve Hollywood's low income community more effectively and has made some solid partnerships with organizations such as Planned Parenthood, Women In Distress and FLIPANY.

With headquarters in the heart of Hollywood, FOH's platform is the family wheel; children, teenagers and parents. Their main goal is to provide specially designed programs and services to low income individuals, families and communities at large with the hope of promoting an improved quality of life and well-being.

FOH has designed 3 very different diverse programs targeting low income children, teenagers and parents at no charge. The Human Understanding and Growth Program (H.U.G.) was designed for children ages 8-12 to develop social behavior, social skills and improve reading comprehension. The Teen Development and Growth Program is another program specially designed for teenage girls ages 13-18. The idea is to expose girls to positive experiences and role models as well as develop positive attitudes and increase their self esteem. The Parent Education Program is the third program developed for parents 19 years and over, hence completing the family wheel that FOH operates from. The program provides parents with tools to increase their knowledge of child development so they may have positive parenting skills and strategies in raising their children.
